IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 2nd day of November, 2015,

entered in the amount of \$7,410.50 against Defendant Jacob Cohen, and in favor of the Plaintiff, Commissioner of the State of New Jersey Department of Banking & Insurance. This amount consists of: \$5,000.00 in civil penalties for one violation of the Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 et seq.; attorneys' fees of \$1,410.50 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; plus \$1,000.00 constituting the surcharge pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1. Moreover, the Commissioner also requests that the Defendant's driving privileges be suspended for a period of one (1) year, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15.
