IT IS on this 3rd day of JUNE, 2016, ORDERED that judgment is entered in the amount of \$7,504 against Defendant Barbara Puglise and in favor of the Plaintiff, Richard J. Badolato,

Acting Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of \$5,000.00 in civil penalties, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b for one (1) violation of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30 ("Fraud Act"); attorneys' fees of \$1,504, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant Barbara Puglise's driving privileges will be suspended for a period of one (1) year from the date of this judgment.
