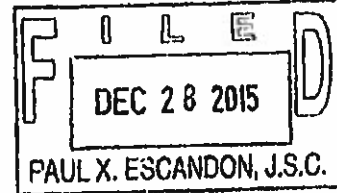

ORDER

SPECIAL CIVIL PART:  
STATUTORY PENALTIES  
AMOUNT IN CONTROVERSY:  
\$14,871.50

THIS MATTER having been opened to the court upon the application of John J. Hoffman, Acting Attorney General by Kristina Cretella, Deputy Attorney General, attorney for Plaintiff, Commissioner of New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance ("Commissioner"), for an Order for Summary Judgment against Defendant Nakisha Jones and the court having considered the papers submitted and for good cause shown:

IT IS on this 28 day of December 2015;

ORDERED that Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment is hereby GRANTED in favor of Plaintiff, Commissioner, against Defendant Nskisha Jones; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that judgment be and is hereby entered in the amount of \$14,871.50, against Defendant Nakisha Jones and in favor of the Plaintiff Commissioner. This amount consists of: civil penalties in the amount of \$5,000.00 for one violation of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 et seq.; attorneys' fees of \$8,871.50, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a statutory surcharge of \$1,000.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant Nakisha Jones' driving privileges shall be suspended for a period of one (1) year from the date of this judgment; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 10 days of the date hereof.
