AMENDED ORDER GRANTING  
SUMMARY JUDGMENT

THIS MATTER having been opened to the court upon the motion of the Plaintiff, Richard J. Badolato, the Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance, for summary judgment in favor of Plaintiff and against Defendant, Ann Vereen, and the court having read and considered the papers submitted, having heard oral argument, and for good cause shown:

IT IS on this 26th day of May 2017,

ORDERED as follows:

1. Summary judgment is hereby granted in favor of Plaintiff and against Defendant, Ann Vereen.
2. Defendant shall pay the sum of \$5,000.00 to Plaintiff as statutory penalties for multiple violations of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b.
3. Defendant shall also pay \$2,960.00 in attorney's fees to Plaintiff's counsel for all expenses incurred in litigation of this matter, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b.
4. Defendant shall also pay a \$1,000.00 statutory insurance fraud surcharge, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.
5. Defendant's driving privileges will be suspended for a period of one year from the date of this judgment, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15.
6. Judgment is entered in the amount of \$8,908.28 against Defendant and in favor of CURE Insurance Company. This amount consists of: \$8,856.78 in restitution pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-26; and \$51.50 in prejudgment interest pursuant to R. 4:42-11.
