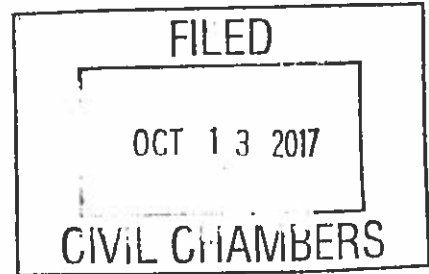

ORDERED, that:


Plaintiff-Intervenor's Motion to Enforce Litigant's Rights to Enforce Settlement on all terms pursuant to R. 1:10-3 against the Defendants, Viking Industrial Security Inc., Viking Alarm Systems Inc., Ralph Day, Sr. and Ralph Day, Jr. is hereby GRANTED;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that judgment shall be docketed as a lien against all Defendants, jointly and severally as a civil monetary penalty in the amount of \$100,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that judgment shall be docketed as a lien against Defendant, Ralph Day Sr. in the amount \$1,000.00 as an insurance surcharge pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that judgment shall be docketed as a lien against Defendant, Ralph Day, Jr. in the amount \$1,000.00 as an insurance surcharge pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.
