



that his wife was a household resident and that he was married to her on his automobile insurance application; and

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 2nd day of October, 2018, entered in the amount of \$11,595.00 against Defendant Adrian Lozano, and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the State of the New Jersey Department of Banking & Insurance. This amount consists of a \$5,000.00 civil penalty pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b for one (1) violation of the Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30; attorneys' fees of \$5,595.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant Adrian Lozano's driving privileges will be suspended for a period of one (1) year from the date of this judgment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 7 days of the date of receipt.
