Defendant, Keven Morgan ("Defendant"), having been duly served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint in the above-entitled action and default having been entered for failure to appear, answer, or otherwise defend:

THIS COURT now finds that Defendant violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act ("Fraud Act"), specifically N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4a(1)-(2), by providing false invoices to an

insurance company in support of a claim for insurance benefits, Defendant presented and made written statements in support of a claim for payment or other benefit pursuant to an insurance policy, knowing that the statements contained false or misleading information; and


FINAL JUDGMENT is on this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 2018, entered in the amount of \$8,693.00 against Defendant, Keven Morgan, and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of \$5,000.00 in civil penalties pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b for one (1) violation of the Fraud Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30; attorneys' fees of \$2,693.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b; and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant Keven Morgan's driving privileges shall be suspended for a period of one (1) year from the date of this judgment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 7 days of the date of receipt.
