The Defendant, Lenore Paone, having been duly served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint in the above-entitled action and default having been entered for failure to appear, answer or otherwise defend;

This Court now finds that Defendant Lenore Paone, violated New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30 ("Fraud Act"), specifically, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-

4a(1); by knowingly providing false and misleading information in support of an insurance claim by falsely reporting that her vehicle sustained damage on August 19, 2015; and

FINAL JUDGMENT is on the 7th day of December 2018, entered in the amount of \$11,342.00 against Defendant Lenore Paone and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, the Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of \$5,000.00 in civil penalties, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b for one violation of the Fraud Act; attorneys fees of \$5,342.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5b of the Fraud Act; and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1 of the Fraud Act.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A 39:6A-15, Defendant Lenore Paone's driving privileges will be suspended for a period of one year from the date of this judgment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within seven (7) days of the date of receipt.
