The Defendant, Steven T. Herder, having been duly served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint in the above-entitled action and default having been entered for failure to appear, answer or otherwise defend;

This Court now finds that Defendant Steven T. Herder violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30 ("Fraud Act") by knowingly providing false or

misleading information to an insurance company in five fraudulent claims for payments pursuant to an insurance policy; and

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 29 day of March 2019, entered in the amount of \$29,895.99 against Defendant Steven T. Herder, and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the State of New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of: a \$25,000.00 civil penalty for the fifteen (15) violations of the Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30; attorneys' fees of \$3,836.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5; cost of service in the amount of \$59.99, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5; \$1,000.00 constituting the statutory surcharge pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1; and restitution to AFLAC in the amount of \$122,715.20, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-26.
