**AMOUNT IN CONTROVERSY: \$7,045.50**

Defendant, Fredi A. Gonzalez ("Defendant"), having been  
 duly served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint in the above-  
 entitled action and default having been entered for failure to  
 appear, answer, or otherwise defend;

This Court now finds that Defendant violated the New  
 Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30,  
 specifically N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(1), by knowingly providing false

or misleading information in support of a 2016 insurance claim to Progressive Garden State Insurance Company; and

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 31<sup>st</sup> day of May, 2019, entered in the amount of \$7,045.50 against Defendant, Fredi A. Gonzalez, and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of \$5,000.00 in civil penalties for one violation of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30; attorneys' fees of \$1,045.50 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant's driving privileges will be suspended for a period of one (1) year from the date of this judgment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 8 days of the date of receipt.
