AMOUNT IN CONTROVERSY: \$9,742.00

Defendant, Judith Morris a/k/a Judith Morris-Chambers a/k/a
Judith Morris Chambers ("Defendant"), having been duly served
with a copy of the Summons and Complaint in the above-captioned
action and default having been entered for failure to appear,
answer, or otherwise defend;

This Court now finds that Defendant violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30 ("Fraud Act") by knowingly providing false and misleading statements on both an application for automobile insurance and a renewal questionnaire, in violation of N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(4)(b); and

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 30th day of August 2019, entered in the amount of \$9,742.00 against Defendant Judith Morris a/k/a Judith Morris-Chambers a/k/a Judith Morris Chambers and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of: a \$5,000.00 civil penalty for one violation of the Fraud Act, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); attorneys' fees of \$3,742.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant's New Jersey driving privileges shall be suspended for a period of one year from the date of this judgment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 5 days of the date of receipt.
