**AMOUNT IN CONTROVERSY: \$8,859.00**

Defendant, Derek W. Monge ("Defendant"), having been duly served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint in the above-captioned action, and default having been entered for Defendant's failure to appear, answer, or otherwise defend;

This Court now finds that Defendant violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30, specifically N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(1) and N.J.S.A. 17:33A-

4(a)(2), by making false statements and submitting fraudulent "Doctor's Notes" to Liberty Mutual Insurance Company in support of a workers' compensation claim as evidence that he was examined and received medical treatment at Robert Wood Johnson hospital on May 30, 2017, when, in fact, he never received treatment at or visited said medical facility; and

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this                    day of                    2020, entered in the amount of \$8,859.00 against Defendant, Derek W. Monge, and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of \$5,000.00 in civil penalties for one violation of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30; attorneys' fees of \$2,859.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.
