**ORDER OF FINAL JUDGMENT
BY DEFAULT
AS TO JONATHAN L. DESIR ONLY**

The Defendant, Jonathan L. Desir ("Defendant"), having been duly served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint in the above-entitled action and having been defaulted for failure to appear, answer or otherwise defend;

This Court now finds that Defendant violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, specifically N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(1), by knowingly providing false and misleading

statements to Liberty Mutual Insurance Company ("Liberty Mutual") in support of an insurance claim.

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 2nd day of November, 2020, entered in the amount of \$21,817.50 against Defendant Jonathan L. Desir, and in favor of the Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of \$15,000.00 in civil penalties for two violations of the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30; attorneys' fees of \$5,752.50 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5; cost of service in the amount of \$65.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5; and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant's driving privileges shall be suspended for a period of one year from the date of this judgment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 7 days of the date of receipt.
