**ORDER FOR FINAL JUDGMENT BY
DEFAULT**

AMOUNT IN CONTROVERSY: \$6,000.00

THIS MATTER HAVING BEEN opened to the Court on the application of Gurbir S. Grewal, Attorney General of New Jersey, (by Ashleigh Shelton, Deputy Attorney General, appearing), attorney for Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey

Department of Banking and Insurance on a motion for final judgment by default; and

FINAL JUDGMENT is on January 22, 2021 , entered in the amount of \$6,000.00 against Defendant Edwin Colon and in favor of Plaintiff, Marlene Caride, Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of: a \$1,500.00 civil penalty for one violation of the Fraud Act, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); attorneys' fees of \$3,500.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant's driving privileges shall be suspended for a period of one year from the date of this judgment.

A copy of this order shall be served on all parties by the moving party within 10 days. A party represented by an attorney shall be deemed served by uploading to eCourts.
