IT IS on this 7th day of **July, 2022 ORDERED** that:

Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment is hereby GRANTED for the reasons expressed on the record, and judgment is entered in favor of the Plaintiff and against the Defendant in the amount of \$12,532.50, which consist of a penalty of \$5,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); a \$1,000.00 surcharge pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1; and \$6,532.50 in attorney fees pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); and

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the driving privileges of Defendant will be suspended in the State of New Jersey for one year effective the date hereof, because he has violated the Fraud Act pertaining to a claim for damages arising out of a motor vehicle accident, as mandated by to N.J.S.A. 39A-15; and

It is FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this order shall be served upon all parties within seven (7) days.
