**ORDER FOR FINAL JUDGMENT BY  
DEFAULT**

THIS MATTER HAVING BEEN opened to the Court on the application of Matthew J. Platkin, Attorney General of New Jersey, (by Anna M. Lascurain, Deputy Attorney General, appearing), attorney for Plaintiff, Justin Zimmerman, Acting Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking

and Insurance on a motion for final judgment by default; and

Defendant, Maurice Wright ("Defendant"), having been duly served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint in the above-captioned action and default having been entered for failure to appear, answer, or otherwise defend;


This Court now finds that Defendant violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30 ("Fraud Act"), specifically N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(1) and -4(a)(3) N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(c) and N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(2), by knowingly providing false and misleading information in support of a claim for payment or other benefit from an insurance policy issued by Progressive Insurance Company ("Progressive") on or about March 27, 2020 and, in addition, by conspiring with another individual to provide a false statement in support of the false claim;

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 9 day of August 2024, entered in the amount of \$14,810.00 against Defendant Maurice Wright and in favor of Plaintiff, Justin Zimmerman, Acting Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of: a \$10,000.00 civil penalty for two violations of the Fraud Act, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); attorneys' fees of \$3,810.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15,

Defendant's driving privileges shall be suspended for a period of one year from the date of this judgment; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 7 days of the date of receipt.
