**ORDER OF ENTRY OF  
FINAL JUDGMENT BY DEFAULT**

\$7,179.00**

Defendant, Christian Gomez Jadalla ("Defendant"), having been duly served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint in the above-captioned action and default having been entered for failure to appear, answer, or otherwise defend; and


This Court now finds that Defendant violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30 ("Fraud Act"), specifically N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(1), by knowingly providing false statements in support of his insurance claim with Allstate New Jersey Insurance Company ("Allstate")

dated May 23, 2016, specifically, by falsely representing to Allstate that he did not sustain any injuries prior to his automobile accident on March 6, 2016, when in fact, he sustained a fracture to his clavicle in a prior accident which occurred on January 31, 2016; and

**FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 6 day of SEPTEMBER 2024**, entered in the amount of \$7,179.00 against Defendant, Christian Gomez Jadalla, and in favor of Plaintiff, Justin Zimmerman, Acting Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance. This amount consists of \$5,000.00 in civil penalties for one violation of the Fraud Act, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); attorneys' fees of \$1,179.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000.00, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:6A-15, Defendant Christian Gomez Jadalla's driving privileges shall be suspended for a period of one year from the date of this judgment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 7 days of the date of receipt.
