**ORDER FOR FINAL JUDGMENT
BY DEFAULT**

GRANTED

THIS MATTER HAVING BEEN opened to the Court on the application of Matthew J . Platkin, Attorney General of New Jersey, Sean Healy, Deputy Attorney General, appearing, attorney for Plaintiff, Justin Zimmerman, Acting Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance ("Plaintiff"), on a motion for final judgment by default; and Defendant, Franklin Beeg ("Defendant"), having been duly served with a copy of the Summons and Complaint in the above-captioned action, and default having

been entered for Defendant's failure to appear, answer, or otherwise defend;

This Court now finds that the Defendant violated the New Jersey Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-1 to -30 ("Fraud Act"), specifically 17:33A-4(a)(4)(b) and N.J.S.A. 17:33A-4(a)(5), by making a false oral statement to Progressive Direct Auto Insurance Company on or about February 12, 2021 for the purpose of reinstating his automobile insurance policy, and by knowingly failing to disclose and/or concealing that he had been involved in an automobile accident just days prior to reinstating his policy.

FINAL JUDGMENT is on this 9th day of ^{December} 2024, entered in the amount of \$6,000 against Defendant, and in favor of Plaintiff. This amount consists of \$2,500 in civil penalties for one violation of the Fraud Act, N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); attorneys' fees of \$2,500 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5(b); and a statutory fraud surcharge of \$1,000 pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:33A-5.1.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be served upon all parties within 7 days of the date of receipt.
