Financial analysis includes the review of annual and quarterly insurer financial statements and all related supplemental regulatory filings to assess and monitor the current financial condition and prospective financial solvency of insurance companies. Financial examination includes investigating and analyzing insurance company risks, policies, procedures, and controls to assess and monitor the current financial condition and prospective financial solvency of insurance companies.
