#### of Postponement of Certificate of Need Call New Pediatric Intensive Care Beds

notice that, in compliance with N.J.S.A. 26:2H-1 et seq. (P.L. 1986, c. 36, as amended), and N.J.A.C. 8:33, Jeffrey A. Brown, Acting Commissioner, New Jersey Department of Health (Department), hereby notice that the September 1, 2025, call for certificate of need applications for new pediatric intensive care beds (PICU), is hereby postponed. On October 2, 2017, the Department issued a certificate of need call for PICU beds. See 49 N.J.R. 3667(c). The call was limited to only those facilities that are currently licensed to provide pediatric intensive care in Essex, Middlesex, Monmouth, Morris, and Passaic counties. At that time, four facilities (Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital-Exeter County, Jersey Shore University Medical Center-Monmouth County, Morristown Medical Center-Morris County, and St. Joseph's Regional Medical Center-Passaic County), were awarded a total of 22 PICU beds. On April and May of 2023, the Department surveyed the facilities that were previously awarded PICU beds. The data the Department received from the facilities indicated St. Joseph's Regional Medical Center had not been awarded the six PICU beds for Passaic County that it was awarded in accordance with the provisions at N.J.A.C. 8:33-3.10(a)1. CN awards are valid for five years, unless otherwise indicated by the CN call. This means that the CN award for the unimplemented beds is no longer valid. Therefore, the Department must continue its efforts in determining if a need exists on a Statewide level for PICU beds. Therefore, the Department is conducting a survey to obtain updated information to determine if a need exists for more beds. The survey seeks the number of admissions, the number of patient days, and the average patient length of stay from each facility with PICU beds. The postponement will allow the Department sufficient time to complete its evaluation of need, and to also provide potential applicants with sufficient time to respond appropriately to a certificate of need call notice in the event the Department determines that a call is warranted. If the Department proceeds with the call, then a call for PICU will be published in an upcoming publication of the New Jersey Register, providing the necessary time for both potential applicants and interested parties to respond to the call notice. In the alternative, if the decision is made to cancel the call, then the Department will publish a cancellation notice in the New Jersey Register.

### DEPARTMENT OF BANKING AND INSURANCE OFFICE OF FINANCIAL SOLVENCY REGULATION Notice of Public Hearing on the Exportable List N.J.A.C. 11:1-34

Take notice that the Department of Banking and Insurance (Department), pursuant to N.J.S.A. 17:22-6.43 and N.J.A.C. 11:1-34, will hold a public hearing on classes of insurance coverages or risks for which there is no reasonable or adequate market among authorized insurers in New Jersey (Exportable List) on the date indicated below. N.J.S.A. 17:22-6.43 provides that the Commissioner of the Department may declare eligible for export any class or classes of insurance coverage or risk for which, after a hearing, he determines that there exists no reasonable or adequate market among authorized carriers in New Jersey. The hearing shall address any additions or deletions to the Exportable List, which is set forth at N.J.A.C. 11:1-34.6. Persons who wish to add or delete items from the current Exportable List should present sufficient evidence that the market conditions of procurability have changed. These persons should also demonstrate whether there exists a reasonable or adequate market among authorized insurers.
