Pursuant to Article 2, section 2.2 of the Delaware River Basin Compact (Public Law 87-328, approved September 27, 1961), I hereby appoint you as a member of the Delaware River Basin Commission, to serve as the representative of the United States.

As the representative of the United States, you will be working closely with Federal and State agencies to develop a coordinated water resources program for the Delaware River Basin. I know you will also want to work closely with the Director of the Office of Management and Budget in view of the unique arrangement for financing the Delaware River Basin Commission.

The Governors of Delaware, New Jersey, New York and Pennsylvania have been informed of your appointment, and I am asking the Director of the Office of Management and Budget to notify the interested agencies. Please accept my best wishes for every future success as you undertake this important new responsibility, which is a natural extension of the excellent job you are doing as Secretary of the Interior.
