

TREB 2022 Timeline

Complete

- Nov-Dec 2020 Coordinate contributors and budget
- Jan-Feb 2021 Contracting with authors, report formatting
- April-Sep 2021 Data gathering & analysis
 - Multiple steering committee meetings in 2021
- December 2021 First
 submissions of indicator and chapter drafts

Ongoing/upcoming

- March 2022 First review round began
 - April 29, 2022 First review round deadline, input returned to authors for editing
 - July 2022 Draft 2 review begins
- October 2022 Goal for release
- Jan-June 2023 SOE translation of TREB





 - Next version will be completed in 2026
- How much have we "moved the needle?"
 - Annual survey for practitioners in the Estuary is now open
 - Survey link to be distributed
 - Practitioners encouraged to submit information about monitoring projects as regularly as is appropriate
- Survey information will greatly assist monitoring inventory update work in 2025-2026
 - Top 10 priorities list to be updated based on survey feedback
