



Storage Study Phase I

Water Availability – Climate Adaptation – Flow, Drought, and Salinity Management



- Initiated in 2021
- Performed by Mott MacDonald (RFP)
- Scope
 - Inventory Potential Sources
 - Develop screening criteria
 - Evaluate and prioritize reservoirs
 - Screened to 14 projects
- Vetted through WMAC
- Report Issued in April 2023



 - Sponsored by DRBC/NYCDEP





Storage Study Phase II

- Resolution for the Minutes approved in June 2024.
- Two track study with Mott MacDonald (MM)
 - 3 Quarries (Penn Park, Evansville, Moores Station / Trap Rock)
 - Cannonsville expansion
- Requires 3 different contracts
 - DRBC & MM for 3 Quarries awaiting signatures
 - DRBC & NYCDEP for Cannonsville work contract framework established
 - DRBC & MM for Cannonsville pending DRBC/NYCDEP contract
