Subcommittee on Source Water Protection Meeting Highlights

Thursday, November 14, 2024 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

Call to Order

The first meeting of the DRBC Subcommittee on Source Water Protection (SSWP) was started by the DRBC staff liaison, Chad Pindar. The meeting was held both in-person and virtually using the Zoom meeting platform. The in-person meeting took place at the New Jersey American Water Company (NJAWC) Delran water treatment facility. Administration

- Roll Call:
 - Committee liaison Chad Pindar performed roll-call for reserved and non-reserved subcommittee constituencies. A list of attendance is provided at the end of these meeting highlights.
- Welcome:
 - Steve Tambini (DRBC) provided a welcome to attendees and thanked NJAWC for hosting the first meeting of the new SWPP. NJAWC showed a safety video.
- Chair & Vice Chair:
 - In accordance with Resolution 2024-5, a Chair and Vice Chair need to be elected annually for the SSWP. Kristi English (PAWC) made a motion to nominate Will Whalon (PWD) and Erin Schulberger (BCWSA) to serve as Chair and Vice Chair respectively. The motion was seconded by Dan Preston (NPWA). There was no discussion and there were no abstentions; the motion passed unanimously.

• Subcommittee Chair Will Whalon (PWD) did a brief recap of the morning's presentations and initiated a brief discussion on future subject matters for the subcommittee.

Session 2: Agency SWP Roundtable Discussion

- Doug Rambo (DNREC) updating SWP plans, delineation of zones, statewide PFAS studies
- Ben Swartz (NJDEP) overhaul of SWP program (first since early 2000's), C1 waters, SRRF funds
- Susan Van Patten (NYSDEC) DWSP2 program, state funding for technical assistance, 604(b)3 \$
- Matt Waldron (PADEP) Updating SWP guidance, technical support, HAB SOP, zone delineations
- Katie Lynch and Beth Garcia (EPAR2, EPAR3) success of sourcewater collaboratives hinges on partnerships, NE-Mid Atlantic Forest & Water Partnership, resilient utilities, NYCDEP program/FAD

Session 3: Utility Roundtable

- PWD climate resilience planning, floatables, PFAS & emerging contaminants, future interest in funding on-the-ground projects in the Delaware, similar to SRRF
- North Penn Water Authority Point Pleasant Pump user, increased communication & coordination with others
- Aqua PA revamping SW/GW priorities, Watersuite, internal dashboard of risks
- Middlesex Water D&R canal user, focus on PFAS, HABs, emergency response and drills
- NJAWC drone program, revamping SWP program, PFAS, 1,4 dioxane
- PAWC new program staffing for PA and NJ, new intake monitoring equipment, HABS, cyanotoxins, communication and sharing of information, train derailments
- LCA PFAS, 1,4 dioxane

Public Input: No one from the public offered any comments or requests.

Administration:

• The subcommittee discussed future potential agenda items/topics as well as the frequency of future meetings and the merits of in-person vs. virtual meetings. There was interest in drills or other types of spill response exercises, emerging contaminants, HABs and hazard inventories. The group appeared to coalesce around having two meetings in CY2025, a virtual meeting in the Spring (before June) and an in-person meeting in the Fall (Oct – Nov). Chad Pindar will work with Will Whalon (Chair) and Erin Schulberger (Vice Chair) on selecting future meeting dates as well as future meeting agenda items.

Adjournment:

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made and seconded. The motion passed and the meeting was adjourned. NJAWC later offered a tour of the treatment plant for members.
