- Resolution for the Minutes honoring Senator Thomas Carper (DE)
- Resolution 2024-7 pursuant to 10.4 of the Compact to preserve and protect water supplies during persistent dry conditions:
 1. Declared a “water supply emergency”
 2. Existing water users continue as are
 3. Special permit No. 2024-01 issued – coordinated operation of reservoirs & diversions
 4. Consumptive Use Make Up for electric generating or co-generating facilities – “critical hydrologic condition” will exist whenever the Trenton EFO is less than 3,000 cfs
 5. States are leads for county or state drought declarations, implementation & enforcement
 6. Interference & Impairment – DRBC’s E.D. has authority to act and resolve issues
 7. Maximum water use efficiency encouraged
- Resolution 2024-8 for operations at Lake Wallenpaupack and Mongaup system
- Resolution for the Minutes – amending DRBC’s Administrative Manual
