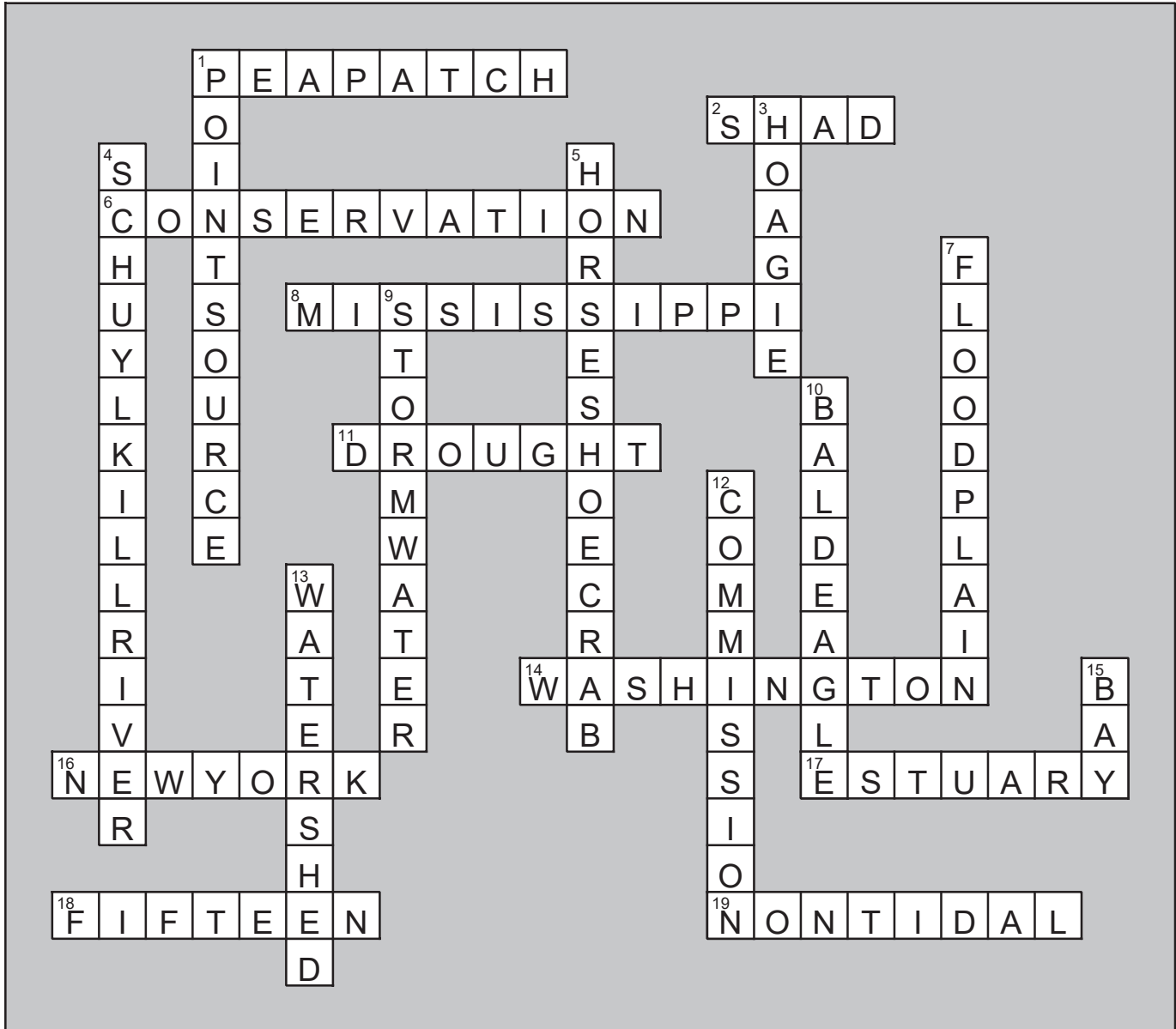


Delaware River Basin Crossword
