

DRBC Biomonitoring Locations

The DRBC's non-tidal Delaware River Biomonitoring Program surveys sediment, rocks, algae, aquatic insects and water chemistry throughout the non-tidal 200 miles of the Delaware River from Hancock, N.Y. to Trenton, N.J.

Data from this program provide a complete overview of the diversity and health of the aquatic life community and overall water quality of this stretch of river, which is protected by DRBC's Special Protection Waters (SPW) regulations.
