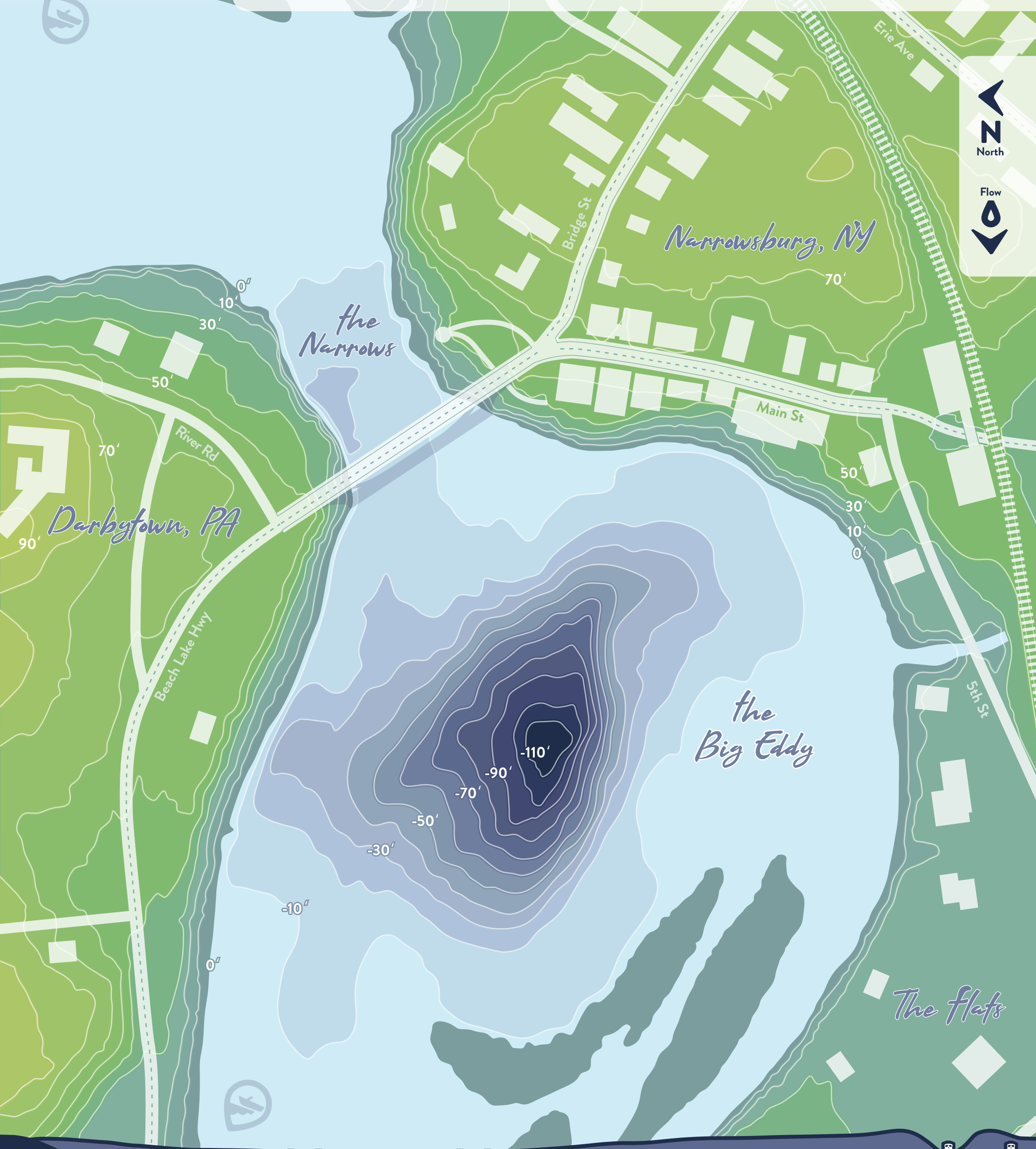


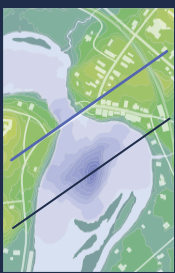
Big Eddy Narrows

Contour lines on the map represent height above or below the riverbank.

The riverbank at Big Eddy Narrows is 675 feet above sea level and 290 river miles from the Atlantic Ocean.
