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JOB DESCRIPTION

DEFINITION:	Under general supervision of an Administrative Analyst 4, Procurement or other supervisory official in a state department, institution, or agency, assists in the review and analysis of procurement transactions, proposals, goods, commodities or services, in order to ensure efficient and effective procurement; does related work as required. Preference will be given to candidates with knowledge of: purchasing methods, practices, and routines, in addition to methods associated with procurement through the competitive bidding process.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE:	NOTE: Applicants must meet one of the following or a combination of both experience and education. Thirty (30) semester hour credits are equal to one (1) year of relevant experience. Seven (7) years of professional experience in the procurement/purchasing process through the competitive bidding process for a large public or private organization. OR Possession of a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university; and three (3) years of the above-mentioned professional experience. OR Possession of a master's degree in Business Administration, Public Administration, Economics, Finance or Accounting; and two (2) years of the above-mentioned professional experience. NOTE: "Professional experience" refers to work that is creative, analytical, evaluative, and interpretive; requires a range and depth of specialized knowledge of the profession's principles, concepts, theories, and practices; and is performed with the
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	authority to act according to one's own judgment and make accurate and informed decisions.
LICENSE / CERTIFICATION:	Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.

RESIDENCY:	Effective 9/1/11, NJ PL 70 (NJ First Act), requires all State employees to reside in New Jersey, unless exempted under the law, or current employees who live out-of-state and do not have a break-in service of more than 7 calendar days, as they are "grandfathered." New employees or current employees who were not grandfathered and who live out-of-state have one year after the date of employment to relocate their residence to New Jersey or request an exemption. Current employees who reside in NJ must retain NJ residency, unless he/she obtains an exemption. Employees who fail to meet the residency requirements or obtain an exemption will be removed from employment.
DRUG SCREENING:	If you are a candidate for a position that involves direct client care with the Department of Veterans Affairs, you may be subject to pre and/or post-employment drug testing/ screening. The cost of any pre-employment testing will be at your expense. Candidates with a positive drug test result or those who refuse to be tested and/or cooperate with the testing requirement will not be hired. You will be advised if the position for which you're being considered requires drug testing and how to proceed with the testing.
INFLUENZA VACCINATION:	NJ State Law (N.J.S.A. 26:2H-18.79) requires <u>ALL</u> health care facility employees to have the influenza vaccination annually.
