We encourage you to contact the Department's Veterans Service Officers for additional information and assistance.

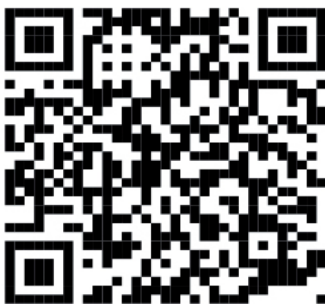

Schedule for the VA Hospital is 10am-2pm.

Appointments at the VA facility need to be scheduled between 9 am and 11 am. Pick up time from VA facility is at 1 pm or earlier if everyone is ready.

located at 537 W. Nicholson Rd in Audubon. Shuttle transfer will drop off at the hospital at 10 am and pick up at 1 pm. Transportation service to the VA Hospital in Delaware is available every Wednesday. Passengers are picked up from their home and drop off time is at 9 am and pick up at 12 pm.

Transportation to the VA Hospital in East Orange can be scheduled Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursdays within a 72-hour notification period. Arrival time from 10 am and return at 2 pm. Transportation to the VA Clinic in Jersey City is available Monday through Friday. Transportation to VA Administrative Offices are available upon request.

Veterans traveling to the Lyons VA Medical Center in Bernards Township from the Lyons Train Station will be able to catch a fare-free ride thanks to a cooperative partnership between Somerset County, the Lyons VA Medical Center, NJ TRANSIT, and the New Jersey Department of Veterans Affairs (DVA). The new Veterans Lyons Shuttle will run 5 days a week, Monday through Friday, from 8:30 a.m. through 4:30 p.m. The shuttle will run from the Lyons Train Station to the Lyons VA Medical Center and back, in a loop, approximately 8 times daily, supporting and coordinating with the preexisting Morris & Essex Line rail schedule.
