RE: Defeated Budget Update

The defeated budget presentation saved on the public drive at P:\counties\defeated budget info 2011-12\, and posted at <http://www.state.nj.us/education/finance/fp/dwb/defeated/presentation.shtml> has been updated.

On slides 4 and 9, the deadline for the district to send the defeated budget package to the municipality has been updated from May 5<sup>th</sup> to **May 4<sup>th</sup>**. Pursuant to NJSA 19:19-1, the board of county canvassers meets on the Monday subsequent to the election to certify the election results. The defeated budget package must be sent within two days subsequent to the certification, which is **Wednesday May 4<sup>th</sup>**. The department is still encouraging districts with defeated budgets to send the defeated budget package to the municipality within two days of the election, by Friday April 29<sup>th</sup>.

There were also typographical errors on slide 4 which have been updated: the date of the election was Wednesday April 27<sup>th</sup>, and the election results and letter from the county sup to the muni occurred on Thursday April 28<sup>th</sup>.
