This memo is to remind you that the 2011 Visual and Performing Arts Education Survey must be completed online at <a href="http://homeroom.state.nj.us">http://homeroom.state.nj.us</a> by <a href="february 28">February 28</a>, <a href="february 2011">2011</a>.

The survey asks for information on programs in each school in the district. Every district is required to complete the survey online. No paper documentation will be accepted. The login code is the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) assigned 9-digit County, District, School Identification Number combined into a single nine digit number. A school code directory may be accessed at: <a href="http://www.state.nj.us/education/directory/">http://www.state.nj.us/education/directory/</a>. Thank you to those who have already submitted your school data in response to the department's first correspondence on January 13, 2011.

The Visual and Performing Arts Education Survey measures arts course offerings, student participation, dedicated arts resources, district policy, instructional support, and the extent to which community assets are utilized in New Jersey's schools. The survey is part of a broader Arts Education Census Project, a collaborative partnership between the New Jersey Department of Education, the New Jersey State Council on the Arts, the Geraldine R. Dodge Foundation, the New Jersey Arts Education Partnership, ArtPride New Jersey, and Quadrant Arts Education Research. The Census Project will gather, evaluate, and disseminate qualitative and quantitative data regarding the status and condition of arts education throughout New Jersey. The survey findings will be released late in 2011. An in-depth analysis of school data will assist the department and its project partners in understanding the level of student involvement with the arts. Additionally, the survey data will help identify model programs across the state, as well as opportunities to align resources to insure that all students may meet or

exceed the requirements of the New Jersey Core Curriculum Content Standards in the Visual and Performing Arts.
