School Nurse Education Conference

The New Jersey Department of Education is hosting a School Nurse Education Conference on Thursday, July 7, 2011 at the Holiday Inn Somerset from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm. The conference is designed to educate school nurses, regarding public health prevention measures in dealing with emergency situations in the school setting. The conference goals are to highlight current practices and innovations in the following categories:

- Infection control within the nurses' office, the school, and buses.
- Education of students and staff.
- Absenteeism and disease surveillance---reporting absenteeism to public health authorities.
- Exclusion and re-admission of students/staff to school.
- Administration of vaccine—the importance of providing vaccinator assistance during emergency outbreaks.

The conference will be divided into presentations, panel discussions, training refresher-course, and question and answer. The focus will be on practical topics geared toward the H1N1 pandemic and other communicable diseases.
