SUBJECT: English as a Second Language (ESL) Curriculum Development Process

Workshop

This memorandum is to inform you of the upcoming workshop: "The ESL Curriculum Development Process." This workshop will address the **process** of developing ESL curriculum based on the WIDA English Language Proficiency Standards (New Jersey's ESL standards for grades Pre-K-12). District teams of two people – one who has a solid understanding of the WIDA English Language Proficiency Standards and the other who is responsible for curriculum development are recommended to attend.

A committee of New Jersey educators has developed ESL curriculum exemplars that will help to facilitate effective ESL instruction. The exemplar units will be presented for the five grade level clusters: Pre-K, 1-2, 3-5, 6-8, and 9-12, and will serve as models to assist districts in the development of the ESL curriculum. Participants should bring a copy of the WIDA English Language Proficiency Standards which can be downloaded here: http://wida.us/standards/elp.aspx.
