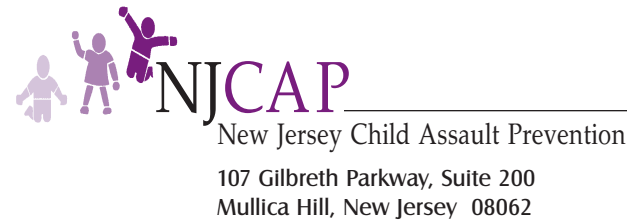

## 2012 NJ Child Assault Prevention (CAP) Award

**Instructions:** The NJ CAP Award was designed specifically to honor those in New Jersey who are or have been involved, in the prevention, intervention or treatment of child abuse and/or bullying. If you know someone who you feel is deserving of such an award, please let us know by submitting a nomination.

Your nomination will be reviewed by the NJ CAP Advisory Board Selection Committee. Through a collective process, they will select the 2012 CAP Award Recipients. The winning recipients will be recognized at a Statewide Luncheon at the Trenton Marriott on **March 30, 2012**.

It is up to you to help the selection committee understand why your candidate is deserving of a CAP Award. It is important for you to include as many details as possible about your nominee. Providing supportive documentation for the nominee's achievements may further clarify the reason this person deserves recognition. Support letters from others who are in agreement with this nomination should be attached to the nomination. If you have questions on how to complete the nomination, do not hesitate to contact the NJCAP RTC office at 856-582-7000 x 158.

Please submit a detailed narrative for each of the following questions:

1. What has the nominee accomplished in the field of bullying and/or child abuse prevention? List specific activities, programs, etc.

5. Does the nominee know about the CAP project? If so, please describe how he/she has supported CAP – programmatically, philosophically, legislatively and/or financially.

2. How many years has the nominee been involved in child abuse and/or bullying prevention or in the specific activity for which he/she is being nominated?

6. What makes this nominee different from others who might be doing the same job, participating in similar activities or accepting similar responsibilities?

7. Why do you feel this nominee is deserving of a statewide child abuse prevention award?

3. Approximately, how have individuals/communities benefited from the nominee's efforts?

4. Please share one or more anecdotal stories about this individual's/agency's work and how it made a difference in the lives of others.
