Re: Language Arts Literacy Training for CTE Teachers and Supervisors

The Office of CTE in partnership with the Southern Regional Education Board (SREB) plans to provide two-day workshops throughout the state for CTE teachers, curriculum supervisors and directors in New Jersey comprehensive high schools, county vocational-technical high schools and charter high schools, in order to facilitate the implementation of The Common Core State Standards for English Language Arts focused on technical subjects. Effective, easy-to-implement instructional strategies that every CTE teacher can use to get students reading and writing to demonstrate learning of course content will be shared. Participants will learn a variety of strategies that help students comprehend technical reading and produce technical writing through six high leverage learning skills: summarizing, paraphrasing, inferring, categorizing, predicting, and vocabulary building.

Participants will additionally gain the following from the two-day workshop:

- Learn the five SREB Literacy Goals and practical strategies to meet those goals;
- Discover how CTE contributes to the five goals and supports student learning in academic areas;
- Use a writing task template that will assist them to implement the <u>Common Core State Standards</u> for technical literacy <u>http://www.corestandards.org/;</u> and
- Have the opportunity to practice writing sample tasks.
