Kindergarten through Grade 12 Behavioral Threat Assessment and Management Training

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:17-43.4, school districts, charter schools, and renaissance school projects are required to establish threat assessment teams. The purpose of a threat assessment team is to provide school teachers, administrators, and other staff with assistance in identifying students with behaviors of concern, assessing students' risk for engaging in violence or other harmful activities, and delivering intervention strategies to manage the risk of harm for a student who poses a potential safety risk. Accordingly, boards of education and boards of trustees must develop and adopt a policy for the establishment of a multi-disciplinary threat assessment team at each school. These policies must align with the <u>Guidance on the Establishment of Behavioral Threat Assessment and Management Teams</u> developed by the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE). Additionally, each threat assessment team member must complete training provided by the NJDOE's Office of School Preparedness and Emergency Planning (OSPEP), which includes this full-day Basic session (8:30 AM – 3:00 PM).
