Invitation: New Jersey Universal Design for Learning (UDL) Innovation Network

The New Jersey Department of Education's Office of Special Education (OSE), in collaboration with CAST, the originator of Universal Design for Learning (UDL), is pleased to invite district and school leaders to an information session on the New Jersey UDL Innovation Network. This new statewide initiative, launching in 2026, aims to strengthen Tier 1 instruction and promote equitable, inclusive teaching practices.

The UDL Innovation Network is a multi-year partnership between OSE and CAST designed to help districts develop proactive, adaptable instructional systems that serve all learners. Selected districts will engage in professional learning, lesson design workshops, instructional rounds, and system-level planning aligned with the UDL framework. This phased approach aims to build district capacity, improve teaching practices, and support sustainable implementation across schools.
