## **Career and Technical Education Scholar Award Program**

In celebration of Career and Technical Education (CTE) Month, the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) is pleased to announce the 2nd annual CTE Scholar Award Program (CTE SAP). This program honors exceptional CTE students across New Jersey. Established under legislation <u>P.L. 2023,c.47</u>, the award highlights the critical role of CTE in preparing a skilled and trained workforce to meet industry demands.

Local Education Agencies (LEAs) with approved CTE programs are invited to participate. The NJDOE, in collaboration with the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development (NJDOL), has developed comprehensive criteria to recognize outstanding CTE students. The legislation outlines four key criteria for this recognition:

- 1. Demonstrate a high level of achievement in a CTE program as exemplified by course grades, industryrecognized technical assessments, and teacher recommendations.
- 2. Demonstrate a high level of achievement in at least three academic classes, as exemplified by course grades, end-of-course assessments, and teacher recommendations.
- 3. Successfully complete a college-level course or a work-based learning (WBL) experience including, but not limited to, employment under a cooperative education agreement, an internship, or a work-based structured learning experience.
- 4. Participate in a career and technical student organization (CTSO) or a community service project that demonstrates the application of career and technical skills.

The CTE SAP application timeline is as follows:

- February 5, 2025 The application window is open for submission
- February 19 and 20, 2025 Information sessions will be held for LEAs
- March 28, 2025 Applications are due in <u>NJ Homeroom</u>
- May 2025 NJDOE recognition of CTE Scholar Award Recipients
