II. First Public Comment

Acting Director Martens also advised the public as follows: individuals wishing to provide public comments/statements during First and Second Public Comment must be speaking about matters on the Commission's agenda; anyone wishing to provide public comments/statements about a matter not on the agenda should reserve their public comments/statements for New Business; anyone offering public comments/statements about a matter on the agenda is asked not to relitigate the merits of their case as the Commission's review of matters is limited to the written submissions; and everyone in attendance is asked to exercise an appropriate degree of decorum as this is a public forum.

9:36 a.m. Laurie Weber, Complainant in C68-20 and C71-20, which were not on the agenda, noted her attendance, and wanted to ask a procedural question related to both matters. Acting Director Martens asked Ms. Weber if she would call the office at a later date, to discuss the matters because they had been adjudicated, Ms. Weber explained that she has attempted to

call the office, but no one answers. It was explained to Ms. Weber that the staff is in the office and will respond to her call after the meeting.

9:39 a.m. Gavin Rozzi, interested party in the matter docketed as C04-20, noted his attendance, but did not offer any public comment/statement.
