Additionally, the record forwarded by the OAL indicates – via a November 11, 2009 letter from counsel for the Board of Education – that K.B. was withdrawn from school to return to Florida, thereby mooting petitioners' appeal of the Board's determination that she was ineligible to attend school in the district. ¹

Accordingly, this matter is no longer deemed to be a contested case before the Commissioner and is hereby dismissed with prejudice.
