SYNOPSIS

Petitioning Board of Education challenged the respondent's appointment of Garnell Bailey to be an Assistant Superintendent in respondent's school district. A hearing in the matter was scheduled for April 23, 2015, but both parties failed to appear. The OAL sent notifications to the parties on April 30, 2015, providing an opportunity to submit an explanation for the nonappearance.

There being no explanation filed by either party, the matter was no longer deemed to be a contested case before the Commissioner. Accordingly, the Commissioner dismissed the petition with prejudice.
