## **SYNOPSIS**

Petitioner filed an appeal in June 2015 challenging the Board of Examiners' determination to deny her application for a Principal Certificate of Eligibility pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9B-11.5. A hearing in the matter was scheduled for November 12, 2015, but petitioner failed to appear. A notice was sent to the parties by the Office of Administrative Law on January 8, 2016, which provided the petitioner with an opportunity to submit an explanation for such nonappearance, but no explanation was filed with the Department.

There being no explanation for the non-appearance filed by the petitioner, the matter was deemed to no longer be a contested case before the Commissioner. Accordingly, the Commissioner dismissed the petition with prejudice.
