Camden County.


The Commissioner has reviewed the record of this matter and the decision of the School Ethics Commission (Commission), finding that respondent violated the School Ethics Act for failure to timely complete school board member training in accordance with *N.J.S.A. 18A:12-33* and *N.J.A.C. 6A:28-4.1*. The Commission's decision was forwarded to the Commissioner for final determination on the recommended penalty pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 18A:12-29(c)*.

The SEC recommended a sanction of removal effective upon the adoption of the decision by the Commissioner. Alternatively, if the respondent completes the required training before the Commissioner issues her final decision, the SEC recommends that respondent be suspended for 30 days. Respondent has neither filed exceptions to the recommended penalty nor instituted an appeal, pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 6A:4-1 et seq.*, of the Commission's underlying finding of violation.

Upon review, the Commissioner concurs with the penalty recommended by the Commission for respondent's failure to timely honor an obligation placed upon board members by law.

Accordingly, respondent is hereby removed as a school official found to have violated the School Ethics Act, effective as of the date of this decision.
