Final Decision

In the Matter of Lily Zou,
Princeton Charter School,
Mercer County.

The Commissioner has reviewed the record of this matter and the decision of the School Ethics Commission (SEC), finding that respondent violated the School Ethics Act (the Act) for failure to timely complete board member training in accordance with *N.J.S.A.* 18A:12-33 and *N.J.A.C.* 6A:28-4.1. Subsequent to the issuance of the SEC's decision, the Commissioner received information demonstrating that respondent has not been a member of the Board of Trustees of the Princeton Charter School since 2019. Accordingly, respondent was not required to complete board member training in 2021. Therefore, the Commissioner concludes that respondent has not violated the School Ethics Act. The decision of the SEC is hereby reversed; and therefore, no penalty is imposed.
