## Re: In the Matter of the Application of Lindsey Reggo for Certification Docket No. 0506-178

Dear Ms. Reggo:

At its December meeting the State Board of Examiners reviewed the appeal that you filed. In your appeal you challenged the determination of the Office of Licensure and Credentials that you are ineligible for certification as a Teacher of Physical Education. After completing an evaluation of your credentials, the Office of Licensing advised you that you must take an additional four credits in physical education, three of which must be at the advanced level.

The Board carefully reviewed your appeal and attachments. It concluded that you failed to show that you had completed a minimum of 30 credits in physical education in a coherent sequence of coursework, with at least twelve of the credits at the advanced level. While you may have taken additional classes, they are not in the subject matter that you wish to teach. Accordingly, because you have provided no evidence to show that you meet the regulatory requirement for a Teacher of Physical Education Certificate of Eligibility, the Board voted to deny your appeal. You must complete four additional credits, with three at the advanced level, in order to be eligible for the certificate.
