At its meeting of May 17, 2012, the State Board of Examiners reviewed an affidavit that the Atlantic County Prosecutor's Office had submitted regarding Anthony DeFeo. In January 2012, DeFeo pled guilty to Criminal Sexual Contact and agreed to forfeit his teaching credential. DeFeo was sentenced to 364 days in the County jail, probation and Megan's Law reporting. DeFeo currently holds a Substitute Credential that expires in January 2014.

DeFeo agreed to relinquish his credential with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the New Jersey State Board of Examiners. At its meeting of May 17, 2012, the Board voted to accept DeFeo's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9-17.8.

Accordingly, on this 17th day of May 2012 it is therefore ORDERED that the revocation of Anthony DeFeo's Substitute Credential be effective immediately.
