CHRISTOPHER F. PETERS : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of February 27, 2014, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit that the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office had submitted regarding Christopher F. Peters. Peters pled guilty to Official Misconduct and Possession of CDS and was ordered to forfeit his teaching certificates. Peters currently holds a Teacher of Elementary School certificate, issued in May 1978, a Teacher of English certificate, issued in May 1979, a Supervisor certificate, issued in July 1988 and a Principal certificate, issued in July 1992.

Peters agreed to relinquish his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of February 27, 2014, the Board voted to accept Peters' relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9-17.8.

Accordingly, on this 27th day of February 2014 it is therefore ORDERED that Christopher F. Peters' Teacher of Elementary School, Teacher of English, Supervisor and Principal certificates be revoked effective immediately.
