Morales pled guilty to Endangering the Welfare of a Child. Morales currently holds a Teacher of Spanish Certificate of Eligibility, issued in October 2006 and a Teacher of Spanish certificate, issued in June 2008. Morales agreed to relinquish his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of July 15, 2014, the Board voted to accept Morales' relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:9-17.8. Accordingly, on this 15th day of July 2014 it is therefore ORDERED that Anthony Morales' Teacher of Spanish Certificate of Eligibility and Teacher of Spanish certificate be revoked effective immediately.
