PAUL W. HOUSER : ORDER OF SUSPENSION

At its meeting of May 22, 2014, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit that the Burlington County Prosecutor's Office had submitted regarding Paul W. Houser. As a condition of his entrance into a Pretrial Intervention Program, Houser agreed to the suspension of his teaching certificates for a period of three years. Houser currently holds a Teacher of the Handicapped certificate, issued in March 1987, a Supervisor certificate, issued in September 1998, a Principal Certificate of Eligibility, issued in June 2002 and a Principal certificate, issued in August 2004.

Houser agreed to the suspension of his certificates and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of May 22, 2014, the Board voted to accept Houser's affidavit agreeing to the suspension of his certificates for three years.

Accordingly, on this 22nd day of May 2014 it is therefore ORDERED that Paul Houser's Principal Certificate of Eligibility, and his Teacher of the Handicapped, Supervisor and Principal certificates be suspended for a period of three years, effective immediately.
